



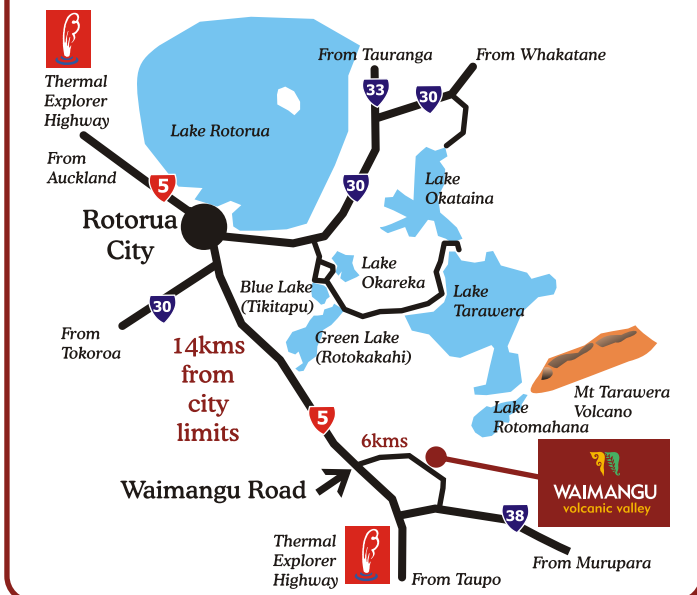

Where is Waimangu Volcanic Valley?

Situated in New Zealand's North Island, the protected Scenic Reserve of Waimangu Volcanic Valley and Lake Rotomahana is found off State Highway 5 [the main Rotorua - Taupo highway], 20 minutes south of Rotorua or 45 minutes north of Taupo.

HOW TO FIND WAIMANGU VOLCANIC VALLEY:

Turn left 14kms south of Rotorua off State Highway 5 (Rotorua - Taupo highway) and drive 6kms along Waimangu Rd to the entrance and carpark.



When is Waimangu Volcanic Valley open?

Waimangu is open daily all year from 08.30.

Last admissions are as follows:

Waimangu Easy Walking

15.45 for a 17.00 close, except January - 16.45 for an 18.00 close

Waimangu Advanced Hiking

14.45 for a 17.00 close, except January - 15.45 for an 18.00 close

Lake Rotomahana Cruise (Cruise only)

15.15 for a 17.00 close, except January - 16.15 for an 18.00 close

Walk/Hike and Lake Cruise

14.00 for a 17.00 close, except January - 15.00 for an 18.00 close

What to bring and wear

Flat shoes or sandals, camera, comfortable clothing, rain or sun protection as necessary, baby pushchair if required.

For the advanced hiking option, good walking shoes with treaded soles are recommended.

Waimangu provides all visitor material for self guided walks and the boat cruise in French, German, Spanish, Dutch, Italian, Russian, Japanese, Mandarin and Korean.
